2. Select and further research one of the presented topics. Write a 1-2 page paper in which you compare and contrast your district, building, or personal policy/practice for working with students dealing with one of the above. Cite at least one additional reference.
3. Develop an action plan outlining the use of the information gained in improving your support and assistance of students, parents, and staff. You can focus on any or all of the various presented topics.
4. Develop a presentation to your building/district staff based on the presented information. Describe your audience and future use of the presentation.
